

# **Don't Push the Button Stick Puppet Activity**

## **Materials/Tools**

- “Don't Push the Button” book by Bill Cotter
- Printer for printing out the coloring sheets
- 2-3 Printer paper sheets
- Crayons, colored pencils or markers
- Glue or tape
- 6 Popsicle sticks
- Scissors
- Optional: Empty cereal box

## **Instructions**

Step 1: Print out pages 2-3 of this activity.

Step 2: Color the Larrys and Button. You can follow the colors in the book or get creative.

Step 3: This step is optional, but if you want sturdier stick puppets, then glue the printed sheet to cardboard. An empty cereal box would work great.

Step 4: Cut out (with adult supervision) the button and each Larry. You can cut along the shapes or just a box around each shape.

Step 5: Glue or tape a popsicle stick to the back of each cut out shape.

Step 6: Let the glue dry if you used it.

Step 7: You now have stick puppets to act out the book's story. Have fun!
